This bungalow at 1006 South Belle Avenue, built on a rectangular basement, has clapboard siding and a moderately pitched front-facing gable roof with three purlins spaced under the eaves. Seven narrow boards extend vertically from below the gable eaves to the facia board that runs across the top of the balconied front porch which extends the width of the house and is contained beneath the main gable. Four square=turned posts support the porch shelter. The composition tiled roof may have replaced the original.
